

## Sheep Uy Colors



### ***Benja's jacket.***



***Knitted from the top down with raglan sleeves and a simple stranding motif for color transition. A must have basic !!***

Sizes: 2 (4, 6, 8, 10) years, to fit chest: 21(23, 25, 27, 28) inches.

#### Materials:

Sheep Uy colors Merino Soft (Worsted, 100% Merino, 219 meters / 100 grams):

Color A: 140(190, 230, 300, 360) yards appx.

Color B: 160(210, 250, 320, 380) yards appx.

Needles: US 6 and US 7, straight or circular used back and forth.

US 6 and US 7 circular small cable or DPN's for sleeves.

Gauge: 20 sts. - 4 inches in stockinette stitch, after blocking.

## Glossary:

k- knit

p- purl

kfb- knit the same stitch twice, front and back loop (increase).

yo- yarn over.

pm- place marker.

sm- slip marker

W&T: W&T:

1) On a wrong side row: (a) slip 1 st. to right needle with yarn in back, (b) return the slipped stitch to left needles , with yarn in front, (c) turn your work, (d) place marker on right needle.

2) On a right side row: (a) slip a stitch to right needle with yarn in front, (b) return the slipped stitch to left needle with yarn in back, (c) turn your work, (d) place marker on right needle.

## Instructions:

Using smaller needles and color A cast on 48(54, 60, 76, 86) sts.

Work in ribbing stitch 2x2 for 2(2, 2.5, 2.5, 3) inches.

Change to larger needles and place markers:

k 8(10, 12, 14, 16), pm, k 6(6, 10, 10, 11), pm, k20( 22, 26, 28, 32), pm, k6 (6, 10, 10, 11), pm, k 8(10, 12, 14, 16).

## Back neck shape:

1) purl to third marker, sm, p3(3, 5, 5, 6) , W&T.

2) knit to next marker, sm, k3(3, 5, 5, 6) , W&T.

3) purl to next marker p3(3, 5, 5, 6) , W&T.

Repeat 2 and 3 twice more (3 times total).

Next row (righth side): Begin the raglan increases:

Row 1: (knit to last stitch before marker, kfb, sm, kfb) repeat 3 times, knit to the end of the row.

Row 2: purl to last stitch.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until you have 50 (54, 60, 66, 72) sts between markers on back piece.

## Separate sleeves and body:

Knit to first marker, put the first sleeve stitches on a holder, cast on 6(6,8,8,8) sts. for underarm, knit the back stitches, put the sleeve stitches on a holder, cast on 6(6,8,8,8) sts. for underarm, knit to the end.

Body: Work in stockinette stitch 2 rows with color A.

Adding color B work the color chart once.

Continue working with color B until your body measures 8(9, 10, 11.5, 13) inches from underarm.

Change to smaller needles and work in ribbing 2x2 pattern for 2 inches.

Bind off all stitches loosely.

Sleeves:

Slip the stitches on holder to a US 6 (small cable circular needle or dpn's).

Pick up stitches from underarm and join in a circle.

Knit to rows in color A.

Adding color B work the color chart once.

Continue working with color B until your sleeve measures 8.5(9.5, 10.5, 12, 13.5) inches from underarm.

Change to smaller needles and work in ribbing 2x2 pattern for 2 inches.

Bind off all stitches loosely.

Note: wrong side rows are not charted. Work every stitch as appears.

Button bands:

Pick up 74(80, 86, 92, 98) stitches from each front.

Work in ribbing 2x2 pattern 8 rows.

On left front work 6(7, 8, 8,8) buttonholes in row 4, evenly spaced.  
Buttonholes: yo, k2tog.

Bind off all stitches very loosely.

Weave in ends and block your jacket for final shape and measures.
