



How I made my “Happy Yellow Road Hat”

Size: 58 -60 cm , 17 cm High.

Gauge: 14 stitches makes 10 cm at needle 6 (Check your gauge and try with bigger or smaller needle if necessary)

Needles: Circular needle 6 mm - 60 cm and double pointed needles 6 mm

Yarn: Pure wool 100% for knitting and felting. 50 m/50 gram

You will be needing 250 grams

The Hat is made in the round. Cast on 150 stitches on your circular needle and purl one round. Knit 5 rounds.

Decrease:

Knit *13, skp*, repeat in the round, knit 4 rounds

Knit *12, skp*, repeat in the round, knit 4 rounds

Knit *11, skp*, repeat in the round, knit 3 rounds

Knit *10, skp*, repeat in the round, knit 3 rounds

There are 110 stitches on your needles. Decrease evenly over the next round until you have 91 stitches left. You will measure your hat from here. Place marker =). Knit 20 cm and start decreasing again:

Decrease:

Knit *5, skp*, repeat in the round, knit 5 rounds

Knit *4, skp*, repeat in the round, knit 4 rounds

Knit *3, skp*, repeat in the round, knit 3 rounds

Knit * skp*, repeat in the round, knit 2 rounds

Knit *2, skp*, repeat in the round, knit 1 round

Knit *1, skp*, repeat in the round, knit 1 round

Knit * skp*, repeat in the round

And cut yarn, pulling it through remaining stitches. Sew in the yarn ends.

Felt the Hat in 60 C in the washing machine, use a bit of mild detergent for wool. My hat needed felting twice to come together. Then shape your hat and let it dry on your head for a while to get the fit you like.

Tip: If you need a smaller or bigger hat size. Change the part of the description below.

Decrease less or more stitches. Knit a bit longer or fewer centimetres.

There are 110 stitches on your needles. Decrease evenly over the next round until you have 91 stitches left. You will measure your hat from here. Place marker =). Knit 20 cm and start decreasing again:
