

## JUST FUR KICKS Hat



### MITTENS ARE PATTERN F502

To Fit Average Women's Size Head - approximately  
23" circumference

### Materials:

**Just Fur Kicks:** 1—100g ball, color 107

**Galway:** 1—100g ball, color 9 Black

**Gauge:** 12 sts, 16 rows= 4" in 1x1 ribbing on size 10  
needles holding one strand of Just Fur Kicks and Galway  
held together.

**Needles:** US Size 10-16" circular needle, set of size 10 double  
points, stitch markers.

**NOTE:** PLYMOUTH ENCORE WORSTED MAY BE  
SUBSTITUTED FOR GALWAY.

With 1 strand Just Fur Kicks and 1 strand Galway  
loosely cast on 70 stitches, placing markers every 10  
stitches as you go. Join, being careful not to twist the  
stitches. Place marker to mark beginning of round.  
Work in k1, p1 ribbing for 4", or until Just Fur Kicks  
runs out, ending at the marker designating the beginning  
of the round. Cut Just Fur Kicks, attach a second strand  
of Galway. On the next round, working with a double  
strand of Galway, and removing extra markers as you  
knit, begin stockinette stitch (knit every round), working  
even for 2". On next round, begin decreasing as follows:  
Round 1: (knit 8, k2tog) around.  
Round 2: knit.  
Round 3: (knit 7, k2tog) around.

Round 4: knit.

Round 5: (knit 6, k2tog) around.

Round 6: knit.

Round 7: (knit 5, k2tog) around.

Round 8: knit.

Round 9: (knit 4, k2tog) around.

Round 10: knit.

Round 11: (knit 3, k2tog) around.

Round 12: knit.

Round 13: (knit 2, k2tog) around.

Round 14: (knit 1, k2tog) around.

Round 15: (k2tog) around.

Cut the yarn leaving a 12" tail, thread it through the remaining 7 stitches, draw up tightly and secure. Weave in the ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS: dec= decrease, k = knit, p = purl, RS= right side, sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over, wyif = with yarn in front, wyib = with yarn in back.
