

## ROYAL LLAMA SILK Patterned Fingerless Gloves



**Materials:** 2 hanks Royal Llama Silk- 1 light green, 1 dark green

**Size:** Approx 7 x 7" long.

**Knitting Needles:** US 7 needles.

**Gauge:** Approx. 5 sts = 1" measured over stockinette st.

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### **GLOVES: Make 2**

With Dark green, loosely cast on 35 sts. Knit 2 rows. Change to light green, and begin pattern:

Row 1 (RS): K3, \*p1, k3 repeat from \* to end of row.

Row 2: \*P3, k1 repeat from \* to last 3 sts, p3.

Row 3: K3, \*P1, yo, sl1, k2tog, pss0, yo, p1, k3, repeat from \* across row.

Row 4: Repeat row 2.

These 4 rows form Lace pattern.

Repeat rows 1 -4 until total length is about 7" long, ending on a row 2. Change back to dark green and knit 2 rows. Bind off knitwise.

**FINISHING:** Fold in half with seam at thumb edge of hand. Sew up the side seam for 5". Leave a gap

of 1" unsewn for the thumb, sew up last inch. Weave in all ends.

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
