Super Chunky Keyhole Scarf





Pattern

- CO 17 sts
- Round 1: K5, P1, K5, P1, K5
- Round 2: P5, K1, P5, K1, P5
- Work R1-R2 until the piece measures 25" long
- Make Keyhole: K5, bind off 7 stitches in pattern (P1, K5, P1), K5
- Next Row: P5, cast on 7 new stitches over the gap, join to stitches on other side of the gap, P5
- Work R1-R2 for 7 more inches until entire piece measures 32"
- BO in pattern, weave in ends

Abbreviations

- CO Cast On
- Sts Stitches
- K Knit
- P Purl
- BO Bind Off

The keyhole serves as the function and helps keep the scarf securely in place but, it's also easy to take on and off when running in and out. The detail of the wide ribbed pattern adds the style to this otherwise simple scarf.
