

Celtic Lace Scarf

This scarf is a great addition to any wardrobe. Since it can be made with nearly any wool you can easily customize it to be as warm or as light as you would like. It can be made with a toasty worsted weight, or done as a light spring scarf with a sport or sock yarn.

Materials

Yarn

The scarf pictured was knit in Debbie Mumm Traditions. However, since making the scarf that yarn was discontinued. I recommend Lion Brand Amazing as an alternative.


Needles

US6 straight or circular. Size J crochet hook for edging.
Stitch markers if desired to mark beginning of chart sts.

Lace Key

Key	
	Central Double Decrease cdd (RS) slip 2 sts, knit 1, pass 2 slip sts over (WS) slip 2 sts together, purl next st, pass 2 slip stitches over
	Knit k (RS) Knit (WS) Purl
	Knit 2 Together k2tog (RS) Knit 2 stitches together (WS) Purl 2 Together
	slip knit sk (RS) Slip next stitch as if to knit, knit next stitch, pass slipped stitch over knit stitch (WS) Slip next stitch as if to knit, knit next stitch, pass slipped stitch over knit stitch
	Through the Back Loop tbl (RS) Work the stitch through the back loop (WS) Work the stitch through the back loop
	Yarn Over yo (RS) Yarn Over (WS) Yarn Over

Notes: Chart only includes instructions for the right side. On every wrong side row: K3, P37, K3. **Work 3 garter stitches on both ends of every row.** Ex: K3, then work chart instructions, K3.

Scarf

Notes: Chart only includes instructions for the right side. On every wrong side row: K3, P37, K3.

CO 43.

R1-6: Work garter rows (knit all stitches on both sides).

1. Next 6 rows: On Right Side: K all stitches. On Wrong Side: K3, P to last 3, K3.

2. Next 55 rows: Right side: K3, work lace chart, K3. Wrong side: K3, P37, K3).

3. Next 20 rows: Right side: K all sts. Wrong side: K3, P37, K3.

Repeat steps 2 and 3 five times more, or until scarf is desired length. Work step 2 once more, then step 1. Work 6 rows of garter stitch and bind off. Block lightly.

Abbreviation Key

Please note that we use the American definitions.

st(s)	stitch(es)
CO	cast on
yo	yarn over hook
R	row
BO	bind off
K	knit
P	purl
W	wrap
