PULLOVER • A MANO

Size 38/40 (42/44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

Materials: 450 (500) g of Lana Grossa **A Mano** (100% organic cotton; 110 m/50 g) in Natural/Beige/Dark Brown/Orange/Yellow (**col 9**). Size 6 and 7 mm needles; size 6 mm circular needle, 60 cm long.

Slip garter selvage: On every row: Sl first st kwise, k last st.

Rib patt: K2, p2.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Full-fashion dec: At beg of RS row, slip garter selvage, k1, skp; at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k1, slip garter selvage. At beg of WS row, slip garter selvage, p1, p2tog; at end of WS row, work to last 4 sts, p2tog tbl, p1, slip garter selvage.

Full-fashion inc: On RS row: M1R, 2 sts in from each edge.

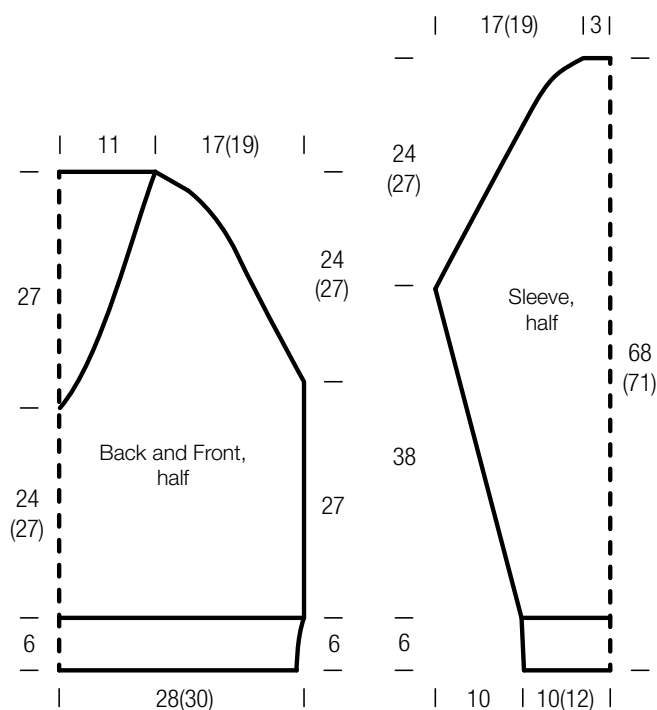
Gauge: 17 sts and 21.5 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 7 mm needles.

Back: With size 6 mm needles cast on 94 (102) sts. Next row (WS): Slip garter selvage, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, slip garter selvage. Next row (RS): Slip garter selvage, k1, * p2, k2; rep from * to last 4 sts, p2, k1, slip garter selvage. Maintaining selvage sts, cont in rib patt as established until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, inc 2 sts evenly across last WS row = 96 (104) sts. Change to size 7 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st until piece meas 33 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 23 (25) RS rows, then dec 1 st at each end of next 6 (8) rows. Bind off rem 38 sts. Raglan should meas 24 (27) cm.

Front: Work same as for back until piece meas 30 (33) cm from cast-on. **Note:** Neck and raglan shaping are worked simultaneously. Raglan shaping for size **38/40** begins 3 cm after beg of neck shaping, raglan shaping for size **42/44** begins at same time as neck shaping. Shape V-neck: Next row (RS): Divide work at center. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 6 times, then every other RS row 9 times. At same time, while working neck shaping, work raglan shaping same as for back. After neck and raglan shaping is complete bind off rem 4 sts for each shoulder.

Sleeves: With size 6 mm needles cast on 34 (42) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, p1, * k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, p1, selvage st. Next row (RS): Selvage st, k1, * p2, k2; rep from * to last 4 sts, p2, k1, selvage st. Maintaining selvage sts, cont in rib patt as established until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, inc 2 sts evenly across last WS row = 36 (44) sts. Change to size 7 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 5th row, then every 4th row 16 times = 70 (78) sts. Work even until piece meas 44 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve cap: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 23 (25) RS rows, then dec 1 st at each end of next 6 (8) rows. Bind off rem 12 sts. Cap should meas 24 (27) cm.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan, side and sleeve seams. **Neckband:** With size 6 mm circular needle and RS facing, beg and end at bottom V, pick up and k 170 sts evenly along neck edge. Next row (WS): Slip garter selvage st, * p2, k2; rep from *, end slip garter selvage. Next row (RS): Slip garter selvage, * p2, k2; rep from *, end slip garter selvage. Maintaining selvage sts, cont in rib patt as established until band meas 2 cm from pick-up row. Bind off all sts in rib. Lap right neckband over left neckband at bottom V. Sew down short edges of right and left band.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) · **ch** = chain · **cont** = continue · **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) · **inc** = increas(e)(ing) · **k** = knit · **kwise** = as if to knit
meas = measures · **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop · **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop · **patt** = pattern · **pm** = place marker · **p** = purl
pwise = as if to purl · **rem** = remain(ing) · **rep** = repeat(s) · **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch · **rnd(s)** = round(s) · **RS** = right side · **sc** = single crochet · **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch · **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch · **sl** = slip · **st(s)** = stitch(es) · **St st** = stockinette stitch · **tbl** = through the back loop · **tog** = together · **wyib** = with yarn in back of work · **wyif** = with yarn in front of work · **WS** = wrong side · **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
