Quick Knit Fingerless Gloves Pattern





What You Need

- A pair of US size 8 (5mm) needles
- Chunky (weight 5) yarn of choice
- Scissors
- Tapestry needle

Instructions

Cast on 23 stitches

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: Knit

Repeat rows 1-4, three more times

Rows 17-22: Knit

Repeat rows 1–4, three more times

Repeat rows 1-3

Bind off leaving a long tail

Fold in half so the beginning and ends of each rows are matched up. Sew ends together using the Mattress Stitch leaving roughly 10 stitches open where the rows of Knit begin for the thumb hole. Weave in ends.

Notes

- This pattern is made for an average/small hand. To adjust for a larger size, cast on 3 more stitches (for a total of 26 stitches), and add 2 more rows of Knit for the thumb section (rows 17–24: Knit).
- If you want longer gloves so it feels more like a gauntlet add another 6 rows of Knit after the first repeat of rows 1-4, then continue in pattern.
- To add colorwork to this pattern, change color every 4th row during repeats and for the rows of Knit (rows 17–22).
