

JOHANNE Cowl with Buttons



Finished size: 26” by 6.5”, approximately.
Gauge: 16 sts = 4” but is not crucial.
Materials: 1 (100g) hank of Johanne, shown in color #10 (will make a few of these); US size 9 needles, tapestry needle, 7 buttons.

Pattern stitch (multiples of 2 +1)

Row 1 and all wrong side rows: Purl.
Row 2: *K2tog, yo, rep from * across; end k1.
(Hint: together stitches lean to the right)
Row 4: K1, *yo, ssk, rep from * to end of row.
(Hint: leans to the left)
Repeat these 4 rows for pattern stitch.

Directions:

Cast on 27 sts with a size 9 needle.
Work in pattern stitch until you have your desired length. Shown is 26”.
Bind off loosely.
Sew buttons to cast on edge. Use the lace openings as buttonholes.

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Abbreviations: K = knit, p = purl, st st = stockinette st, k2tog=knit two stitches together, rep=repeat, ssk=slip one stitch as if to purl, slip another stitch as if to purl, then knit these two stitches together, st(s) – stitch(es), yo = yarn over.
