

BOKU
Ribbed Hat



Materials: Boku -1 ball.

Needles: US 8- 16” circular, and double pointed needles, st marker.

Gauge: 16 sts = 4” on a US 8 needle over st st. (Test gauge over st st)

Finished Size: About 9” long

Hat: Using 16” circular needle, loosely cast on 72 sts. Place marker, and join being careful not to twist the sts.

Work in k2-p2 ribbing, for 7½”, ending at the marker. On the next round, begin decreasing as follows, changing to double pointed needles when needed:

Round 1: (k2, p2tog) around. (54 sts)

Round 2 & 3: (k2, p1) around.

Round 4: (k2tog, p1) around. (36 sts)

Round 5: (k1, p1) around.

Round 6: (k2tog)

around. (18 sts)

Round 7: (k2tog) around. (9 sts)

Cut the yarn leaving a 12” tail, thread it through the remaining 9 sts, draw up tightly and secure. Weave in the ends.
