- 1) Seed 7, K6, seed 7
- 2) Seed 7, P6, seed 7
- 3) Seed 7, Cable 6 front, seed 7
- 4) Seed 7, P6, seed 7
- 5) Seed 7, K6, seed 7
- 6) Seed 7, P6, seed 7
- 7) Seed 7, K6, seed 7
- 8) Seed 7, P6, seed 7

Repeat rows 1-8 until desired length, binding off (loosely!) after a row 6.

Unless you plan to use huge buttons, you don't really need to make a buttonhole—the fabric is loose enough to where you can put a button through wherever you like. Place a button in the corner, and (if desired) one 4" up, same distance in from the edge as the first.

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Size: Approx. 6" x 30".

Materials: 1 Hank DeAire; 1 or 2 medium-large

buttons, 2 stitch markers, cable needle.

Gauge: \sim 10 sts = 4" over st st. Gauge not

important.

Needles: Size 17.

Seed Stitch: (called Seed): K1, P1 on an odd number of stitches. You always knit your purls and purl your knits.

Cable 6 front: Slip 3 sts onto a cable needle and hold to front of work. Knit the next 3 sts, then knit the 3 from the cable needle.

Cast on 20 sts

Setup row: Seed 7, pm, P6, pm, seed 7.
